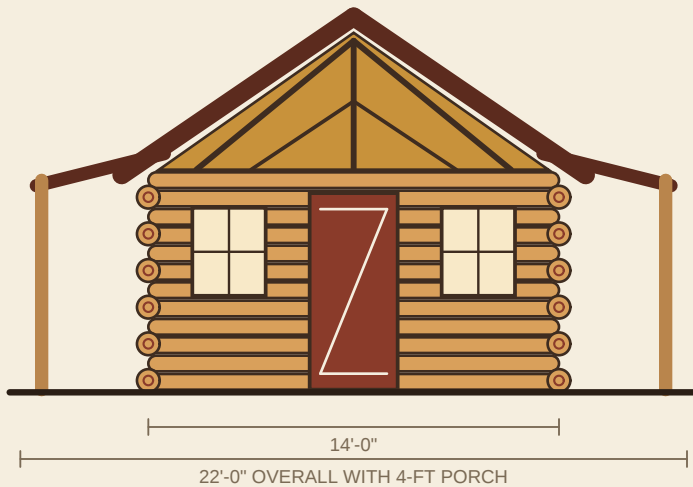

The Camper — \$49,500, delivered & stacked

A 14 × 20 full-log cedar cabin with a wood wrap-around porch, built in batches in our yard, shipped whole on skids, and stacked on your foundation. No plumbing or electrical to wait on — it's off-grid by design, livable the day it lands, and every log was hand-peeled and hand-notched by the same crew that's done it since 1993.

Full-log walls, metal roof, real notched corners

Included in every Camper

- Full-height hand-notched cedar log walls, chinked in your Perma-Chink color
- 4-ft wood wrap-around porch with hand-peeled log posts (6-ft / 8-ft upgrade)
- Two exposed rustic log trusses · 3/4" tongue-and-groove cedar siding ceiling
- Insulated roof structure + metal roof in your color · SureShine stain, in & out
- Delivery and stacking on your rock or concrete foundation (foundation by owner)

The log-shape menu — pick per cabin

Full round (signature)	Full logs, flared butt ends, maximum character	included
Flat inside — customer favorite	Round outside, hand-flattened interior walls	+ \$2,500
D-shape	Flat interior, round exterior, butts kept at corners	+ \$2,500
Flat inside & out	Clean hewn look both sides, fastest to finish	+ \$2,000

Three choices make it yours — on every model



METAL ROOF

Your color from the manufacturer's full palette, over an insulated roof structure.



PERMA-CHINK CHINKING

Creams, tans, beiges, greys, and browns. Classic white is the signature look.



SURESHINE STAIN

Clear and barely-there natural, through honey cedar, to deep antique brown.

Cedar furniture — same hands, same logs

Beds, benches, rockers, and stools built from the same hand-peeled cedar — placed in your cabin before you get the keys.





STRAIGHT TALK

What we build. What you bring.

Included in every cabin

- Hand-notched cedar log walls, stacked by our crew
- Exposed rustic log trusses over an engineered roof
- Wrap-around porch with hand-peeled log posts
- Insulated roof + metal roof in your color
- Car-siding ceilings · chinking · SureShine stain
- Delivery and stacking on your foundation
- Turnkey models: interior walls, electrical, plumbing —
■ with Sticks & Stones as your general contractor

You (or your builder) provide

- Your land, with clear access for the truck
- Rock or concrete foundation (requirements supplied)
- Utility service to the site, on models that use them
- Any permits your county requires

That's the whole list. On the Camper there are no utilities to run at all — pour the pad, and your cabin arrives finished.

Tim & Wendy Wilson — Jameson, Missouri

Tim Wilson has built log cabins from cedar he cuts himself since 1993 — more than sixty of them, from playhouses to lake lodges, plus historic restorations and a build featured on national television. He's a craftsman, a family man, and the pastor of the local Baptist church; when Tim says your cabin is built right, that means something around here. Wendy keeps the whole operation human — she's your first phone call, your design sounding board, and your host when you come walk the cabins. The man who fells your logs is the man who notches your corners.
